4. Graduates will be effective communicators, with other healthcare professionals for dispensing medicines with professional ethics and social responsibilities.

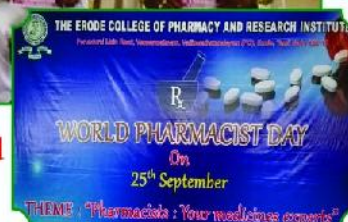

### CDSCO List of banned drugs

CDSCO List of Banned Drugs	Year	Reason
Gemtuzumab ozogamicin (mylotarg)	2010	Withdrawn in the U.S due to increased risk of veno-occlusive disease and based on results of a clinical trial in which it showed no benefit in acute myeloid leukemia(AML)
Rosiglitazone (Avandia)	2010	Withdrawn in Europe because increased risk of heart attacks and death. This drug continues to be available in the U.S
Drotrecogin alfa (xigris)	2011	Withdrawn by Lily Worldwide following results of POWESS-SHOCK study that showed lack of efficacy
